



We all want our students to get a great education and come to school each and every day. # Rosedale Primary School is taking a stance to Bullying.

Over the past two weeks Jacqui has been working with the senior grades in delivering our Bullying Prevention curriculum. Jacqui is currently discussing ways to recognise and respond to bullying behaviour by embedding a three step response: Stop - tell them you don't like their behaviour and ask them to stop; Walk - walk away from the problem behaviour; Then, if the problem doesn't stop Talk - talk to a trusted adult and ask for support. This curriculum will soon be delivered to our junior grades to assist in helping to make our school community a safe and happier place



Some of our activities include:


