SCHOOLS UPGRADE FUND

I AM VERY PLEASED TO ANNOUNCE WE HAVE JUST RECEIVED CONFIRMATION OF A SUCCESSFUL APPLICATION TO THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT'S SCHOOL UPGRADE FUND. THIS PROVIDES US WITH \$25,000 TO COMPLETE OUR OUTDOOR LEARNING SPACE UNDER THE REAR SHADE SAIL IN THE COURTYARD. WE WILL INSTALL ARTIFICIAL TURF AND OUTDOOR SEATING AND TABLES SO THAT WE CREATE, IN ESSENCE, AN OUTDOOR CLASSROOM. THIS WILL BE POSITIONED RIGHT NEXT TO OUR NEW NATIVE GARDEN WHICH WILL PROVIDE A WONDERFUL OUTDOOR LEARNING ENVIRONMENT. THIS ENTIRE SPACE SHOULD BE COMPLETED WITHIN THE NEXT MONTH OR TWO.

WE VALUE THE LOVE AND SUPPORT YOU ALL PROVIDE TO OUR STUDENTS AND WE WANT TO GIVE YOU THE OPPORTUNITY TO SPEND SOME SPECIAL TIME WITH YOUR CHILD/REN OR THE CHILD/REN IN YOUR CARE. BREAKFAST BEGINS AT 8:00 AM AND THE COUNTRY LANE COFFEE VAN WILL BE ON HAND TO PROVIDE FREE COFFEE.

ATTENDANCE

WE ARE CURRENTLY WORKING ON REVISIONS TO OUR ATTENDANCE PROGRAM. WE ARE ONE OF THREE SCHOOLS IN THE NETWORK WORKING WITH DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION STAFF TO DEVELOP A STAGED RESPONSE TO NON-ATTENDANCE. WE ARE DEVELOPING SEVERAL PROCESSES TO REDUCE UNEXPLAINED ABSENCES AND TO WORK WITH FAMILIES TO GET STUDENTS ATTENDING SCHOOL AS OFTEN AS POSSIBLE. A RECENT DEVELOPMENT IS TO ENABLE PARENT NOTIFICATIONS, VIA COMPASS, AT THE BEGINNING OF THE DAY AND AT THE END OF THE DAY. IF A STUDENT IS ABSENT FROM SCHOOL, PARENTS HAVE A LEGAL OBLIGATION TO EXPLAIN WHY. IF THE STUDENT ABSENCE REMAINS UNEXPLAINED BY THE END OF THE DAY, ANOTHER SMS IS SENT OUT. A STAGED RESPONSE MEANS THAT WE WILL BE CONTACTING PARENTS IF STUDENTS HAVE THREE AND FIVE DAYS OF CONSECUTIVE UNEXPLAINED ABSENCES. WE WILL ALSO BE MEETING WITH PARENTS OR CARERS OF CHILDREN WITH ABSENCES BELOW 90%. WE LOOK FORWARD TO WORKING WITH YOU TO MAXIMISE THE AMOUNT OF TIME STUDENTS SPEND AT SCHOOL.

WE ALL WANT OUR STUDENTS TO GET A GREAT EDUCATION AND COME TO SCHOOL EACH AND EVERY DAY. BY YEAR 10 THEY'LL HAVE MISSED MORE THAN A YEAR OF SCHOOL. THERE IS NO SAFE NUMBER OF DAYS FOR MISSING SCHOOL — EACH DAY A STUDENT MISSES PUTS THEM BEHIND AND CAN AFFECT THEIR EDUCATIONAL OUTCOMES. IF FOR ANY REASON YOUR CHILD MUST MISS SCHOOL, PLEASE LET US KNOW SO THAT THEY CAN BE MARKED ABSENT FOR THE APPROPRIATE REASON. OUR GOAL FOR ALL STUDENTS AT ROSEDALE PRIMARY SCHOOL IS TO HAVE LESS THAN 10 DAYS ABSENT PER YEAR. LOOK FOR THE GREEN TICKS OUTSIDE CLASSROOMS DAILY TO SEE WHICH ROOMS HAVE A FULL HOUSE.

PHOTOGRAPHING, FILMING AND RECORDING STUDENTS POLICY

PURPOSE:

To explain to parents/carers how Rosedale Primary School will collect, use and disclose photographs, video and recordings of students, how parent/carer consent can be provided and how it can be withdrawn.

SCOPE:

This policy applies to the general collection, use and disclosure of photographs, video and recordings (images) of students. It does not cover the use of Closed Circuit Television (CCTV).

POLICY:

This policy outlines the practices that Rosedale Primary School has in place for the collection, use and disclosure of images of students to ensure compliance with the Privacy and Data Protection Act 2014 (Vic). It also explains the circumstances in which Rosedale Primary School will seek parent/carer consent and how consent can be provided and/or withdrawn.

As a general rule, use relates to images which are shared and distributed only within the school for school purposes (i.e. ID photos, Compass), whilst disclosure is used for images which are shared and distributed outside of the school staff and are available to other students, parents/carers and the wider school community.

Rosedale Primary School will ensure that parents/carers are notified upon enrolment and at the commencement of each school year of the ways in which our school may use images of students. There are many occasions during the school year where staff photograph, film or record students participating in school activities or events, for example classroom activities, sports events, concerts, excursions, camps etc. We do this for many reasons including to celebrate student participation and achievement, showcase particular learning programs, document a student's learning journey/camps/excursions/sports events, communicate with our parents/carers and school community in newsletters and on classroom blogs/apps/insert etc].

Rosedale Primary School will use student images reasonably, appropriately and sensitively, consistent with our obligations under the Child Safe Standards and our school's Child Safe Policies. If at any time a parent/carer or student has a concern about the use of any images they should contact the Principal on 0351 992473 or rosedale.ps@education.vic.gov.au.

In addition to the processes outlined below, parents/carers can contact the Principal at any time to withdraw their consent for any future collection, use or disclosure of images of their child. However: if the images have already been published and are in the public domain, it may not be possible for consent to be withdrawn.

There may be occasions when the school will record whole of school or large group events [and make those recordings available to the school community through DVD sales etc], such as the school concert, speech nights, sports events etc and if your child participates, they may appear in these recordings which will be available to the whole school community.

The school can still collect, use and disclose images in circumstances where consent is not required (see below for more information).

OFFICIAL SCHOOL PHOTOGRAPHS:

Each year Rosedale Primary School will arrange for official school photographs of students and staff to be taken. This will generally involve both class photos and individual photos being taken.

Official school photographs may be:

purchased by parents/carers

used for school identification cards

stored on CASES21 and Sentral for educational and administrative purposes.

Rosedale Primary School will notify parents/carers in advance of the official school photographs being taken to give them an opportunity to decide whether their child will be included in the official school photographs.

Parents/carers who choose to opt-out of having their child participate in official school photographs must contact the School Office on 0351 992473 before the date photos are scheduled to be taken to advise that their child will not participate. There is no obligation on any parent or carer to purchase any photographs taken.

IMAGES FOR USE AND DISCLOSURE WITHIN THE SCHOOL COMMUNITY AND ORDINARY SCHOOL COMMUNICATIONS:

From time to time Rosedale Primary School may photograph, film or record students to use within the school community, including:

in the school's communication, learning and teaching tools (for example, emails, classroom blogs or apps that can only be accessed by students, parents or school staff with passwords eg Compass, Class Dojo etc)

for display in school classrooms, on noticeboards etc

to support student's health and wellbeing (eg photographs of pencil grip to assist in OT assessments)

An Annual Consent Form and Collection Notice will be distributed to parents/carers on enrolment and also at the beginning of each school

IMAGES TO BE USED OR DISCLOSED OUTSIDE THE SCHOOL COMMUNITY:

External use or disclosure by the school

Photographs, video or recordings of students may also be used in publications that are accessible to the public, including:

on the school's website including in the school newsletter which is publicly available on the website on the school's social media accounts

The Annual Consent Form and Collection Notice also covers these types of uses and will be distributed to parents/carers on enrolment and also at the beginning of each school year. We will notify you individually if we are considering using any images of your child for specific advertising or promotional purposes.

photographs, films or records a student for any of these purposes, staff will only collect and use such images in a way that is reasonable and appropriate in the circumstances.

STAFF USE OF PERSONAL DEVICES

School staff may use their own personal devices to capture images of students for reasonable and legitimate educational purposes. If this occurs, staff are expected to upload the images to the school database and delete the images from their device within a week of the images being captured.

Discussed at staff briefings/meetings, as required

Included in transition and enrolment packs

Discussed at parent information nights/sessions


