### Attendance

This year, we are adjusting our approach to school attendance in an effort to increase attendance rates and promote regular student attendance. Now, if your child is absent for two consecutive days in a week, the classroom teacher will be calling you to check in. Bronwyn, our Attendance Officer, will also be calling and emailing parents and carers weekly if any absence is unexplained. Please note every absence needs to be explained. You can explain absences through Compass or by calling our office directly.

### **Spelling Mastery**

Spelling Mastery recommences on Monday for our Year 1-6 students. For those parents and carers unfamiliar with the program, students participate in lessons commencing at 9:00 am sharp, Monday - Friday. The successful implementation of Spelling Mastery relies on punctuality. Our classroom doors open at 8:50am, we mark the roll and get ready to begin learning. Those students who are late miss out on the introduction to the lesson, or the lesson itself, so we urge punctual attendance each and every school day.

### Uniform

It has been great to see the new uniform slowly filtering in and being worn by students. As we continue our transition, we remind parents that bike shorts are not part of our school uniform. We have a range of uniform options, including: skorts, shorts, girls leisure pants or track pants so we really want to see these items being adopted and bike shorts not being worn to school, especially on school excursions.

### New Australia-wide Fire Danger Ratings

As of 1 September 2022, Fire Danger Ratings have changed across Australia.

Fire Danger Ratings provide information so people in affected areas can take action to protect themselves and others.

The higher the fire danger, the more dangerous the conditions and the greater the impact will be if a fire starts.

The new system uses better technology and research to determine fire danger ratings, and was developed using feedback from one of Australia's largest surveys of communities.

The new ratings are designed to be easier to understand and provides clear advice about actions to take.


